

# MAXIM SHALYGIN

COMPOSER | CONDUCTOR | VISUAL ARTIST


Shalygin's compositions include chamber, vocal, symphonic, electro-acoustic music, as well as music for theater, ballet and film. Composer extends the traditional array of playing techniques, not so much by resorting to 'extended techniques', but by unfolding the sounds of the instruments in all their congenial sonority. No academic formulas hence, nor avant-garde radicalisms, but rather a self-conceived scale of playing techniques in its own right that never severs the ties with sonority, and thus allows for maintaining a thoroughly tonal language.
